We can't save democracy just by voting

Edward Ongweso argues that the Supreme Court's recent decisions to overturn *Roe v. Wade*, eviscerate the separation of church and state, and limit the ability of the EPA to monitor pollution emissions show voting is not the only way to save democracy, especially as unelected officials have made these consequential decisions.
